- We received a grant from the One by One Campaign. The grant money comes from the Catholic Foundation. Many families donated money to this campaign and we are reaping the benefits! A grant for school facilities opened up around the time school began. In working with the diocese, Mr. Draheim and I worked with Martin Security to design a plan for security in our buildings. The Peshtigo site received a check for \$30,000. Because St. Mary Parish owns the building, I am working with them to get an intercom system, keyless entry and cameras installed. It will take at least a month to get the installation.
