On behalf of our Communities that Care coalition, we invite you to join us for an important and informative community event on Wednesday, November 19th at 6:00 p.m. at the Bayshore Arts Theater Center (formerly Theater on the Bay).

We'll be showing the "Johnny's Ambassadors" documentary, Cannabis-Induced Psychosis: A Silent Epidemic, which shines a light on the growing crisis of high-potency THC and its impact on youth mental health.
