New student vouchers are awarded annually through a DPI run random selection process. If awarded a voucher, that voucher will cover all costs associated with attending Saint Thomas Aquinas Academy.

Once a student is awarded a voucher to St. Thomas Aquinas Academy, that student is eligible for a voucher each year until they graduate....even if the parents' or guardians' income rises above the income eligibility requirements in the future.

Busing is also available at no cost for students who reside within the Marinette and Peshtigo School Districts.
